

## COMMUNITY ADVISORY

Date: November 10, 2017

A University student reports a burglary that occurred some time between 4:30 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. on Friday, November 10, 2017, in the 400 block of Clay Avenue.

The suspect entered an off-campus residence through an unlocked front door and removed a flat screen television from the living room. The suspect left and was last seen heading towards Vine Street. The suspect could only be described as wearing dark clothing. The residents waited to report the incident until this evening.

Students, especially those who live off-campus, are reminded to keep all doors and windows locked, preferably with a chain lock or deadbolt. Adequate outdoor lighting is an effective deterrent. To minimize the opportunity for theft, students are encouraged to take small electronics and anything of value home while on extended breaks. Remain vigilant and report anything suspicious immediately by calling University Police at 570-941-7777 or Scranton Police by calling 911.
