Following the investigation, the team received sanctions that included probation for one calendar year (i.e., through October 27, 2018) and individuals on the team received sanctions including hosting an educational session on hazing, community service, and mandatory attendance at Athletics department programming. The Athletics department also suspended several students from participation in competitions and placed others on a probationary status. Individuals on the team were found responsible for Hazing, and/or Alcohol violations including Social Host and Furnishing. Sanctions for individuals were administrative (i.e., deferred suspension, disciplinary probation,) and developmental (i.e., educational activities) in nature.
