Nomination Process

All nominations must have the nomination form cover sheet with the information for the nominee and nominator clearly completed. All award nominations* will be submitted to the Leadership Awards committee for decision, so please include a narrative as to why you feel a group/individual should be considered for an award. All nominations should be approximately 250 words and returned to the Center of Student Engagement (TDC 205) by April 8th at noon. No late nominations will be accepted. You can nominate yourself or another student/group. Please make photocopies of this sheet if you are interested in nominating more than one person/group or award.

Awards

Club of the Year-This award recognizes the student organization that has continually improved and assisted in creating a vibrant campus community. Among other examples, this organization may have executed quality campus wide programs, engaged students in meaningful service or involved a large variety of students. To recognize this achievement, a prize of \$500 dollars will be awarded to the recipient for the upcoming academic year.

Program of the Year-This award recognizes an outstanding event or program hosted by a student club or organization.

Cura Personalis Award-This award shall be given to an organization or individual that lives the ideal of *Cura Personalis*. This person/organization will have performed excellent community service at the University, in the greater Scranton community or domestic/international service.

The Magis Award- This award recognizes a student organization that has been in existence for less than 2 years and strives to make improvements in their organization and campus community.

Advisor of the Year-This award recognizes an advisor of a student organization whose work goes above and beyond their job description. This person should contribute to the success of the organization and encourage personal growth in members of the group through providing supervision, support and continuity with the group.

Outstanding Student Leader- This award recognizes the efforts of a student leader who has greatly contributed to student life at The University of Scranton. This student should have maintained a dedication to continually improve his or her leadership qualities, the organizations to which he or she belonged and the campus community as a whole.

Emerging Leader Award-This award recognizes the efforts of emerging leaders at The University of Scranton. Award recipients should demonstrate that they have participated in experiences that have helped develop their leadership skills and that they have taken on roles in co-curricular activities that have increased their responsibilities.

Cultural Award-This award will be given to either a club/organization or a student that is dedicated to spreading the idea of culture around campus. This can be either through a program that has raised diversity awareness or through service work.

All nominations are due to the Center for Student Engagement (DeNaples 205) by noon on April 8, 2013. Incomplete applications will not be considered. All applications will be reviewed by the awards committee. Please include the nomination form with your narrative. Student Employee Award-This award will be given to a work study employee who has exceeded the expectations of the employer and job description. This person works hard with fellow employees and manages time well and is dedicated to the job. The student employee must be nominated by the employer and/or fellow co-workers.

Residence Hall Association Leadership Award-Members of RHA with at least one semester of active service are eligible to be nominated for this award. The RHA Leadership Award is given to an individual who: Promotes the improvement of the quality of life in the residence halls, exemplifies leadership through honesty, integrity and moral character, and empowers residents to have a voice and interact with one another.

Outstanding Peer Educator (C.H.E.W.)- This award will be given to a student who serves as a peer educator within the Center for Health Education and Wellness. An Outstanding Peer Educator is a student who goes above and beyond the call of duty to motivate and educate the student body and campus community, and who promotes the BACCHUS philosophy of empowering students to positively influence their peers. Outstanding peer educators are role models and outstanding presenters and facilitators.

Student Government Senator of the Year- This award shall recognize the Senator on Student Government who contributed to the group through legislation, participation and creative thinking. This student shall be nominated by and voted on by their peers in the Senate.

Outstanding Leadership in the University of Scranton Programming Board-This award shall be given to an individual or committee in USPB that was innovative in its planning and crucial to the success of the board. This award shall be nominated by the Assistant Director of Student Activities and Orientation.

Outstanding Leader in the Commuter Student Association- This award will be presented to an active member or the Commuter Student Association who is committed to enhancing the commuter student experience at The University of Scranton. An Outstanding Leader in the CSA will demonstrate excellence in programming, advocacy and outreach to the commuter student population.
