<b>Board of Trustees</b>	Those policies that pertain to the organization and activities of the Board of Trustees.	Office of the President
<b>Academic and Research<sup>1</sup></b>	Those polices that pertain to student academic requirements, standards, and standing; academic administration and operations; and academic research activities.	Office of the Provost/Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs
<b>Student Life</b>	Those policies that pertain to the rights and responsibilities of student members of the University community, and the activities that support student residential and campus life.	Vice President for Student Life
<b>Employee and Human Resources<sup>2</sup></b>	Those policies that pertain to the employment and worklife of faculty, staff, and administrators.	Vice President for Human Resources
<b>Information &amp; Technology</b>	Those policies that pertain to the collection, management, security and dissemination of data and information by the University and its members, and the management and use of technology resources.	Chief Information Officer
<b>Finance &amp; Administration</b>	Those policies that pertain to the financial and administrative operations of the University, including those guiding student financial aid and billing.	Senior Vice President for Finance and Administration
<b>Facilities</b>	Those policies that pertain to the care and maintenance of University property and facilities.	Senior Vice President for Finance and Administration
<b>Campus Safety</b>	Those policies that pertain to campus safety and security.	Vice President for Student Life

<b>Institutional Advancement</b>	Those policies that pertain to the operations of institutional advancement and alumni relations, excepting those that pertain to the financial and administrative operations of the University.	Vice President for University Advancement
<b>Compliance</b>	Those policies that respond directly to external compliance obligations, including federal, state and other legislation, regional accreditation, or other mandates.
