

## **University Governance Council Charge & Membership 2024-25**

UGC Charge: The University Governance Council (the Council) plays an important role in governance at the University of Scranton. Comprised of the leadership of each of the three representative senates, or their designates, the Council serves as a coordinating structure to review institutional policies, sending its recommendations to the President's Cabinet, the chief policy and decision-making body of the University. The UGC is convened by the Provost & Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs.

The Convener serves as the UGC's administrative liaison\*\* to the President's Cabinet, charged to carry the Council's feedback and recommendations to the Cabinet, and likewise conveying information from the Cabinet to the Council. The Assistant Provost for Planning and Institutional Effectiveness provides administrative support for governance and policy activities.

In addition to institutional policy duties, the UGC also provides an important communication link between administration and representative governing bodies. It also provides a forum for the three governing bodies – Faculty Senate, Staff Senate, and Student Government – to have opportunity to discuss other University issues and senate/constituent initiatives with one another.
