Emergency Notification

- For security, injury or all emergency calls, contact University Police at 570-941-7777 or call 9-1-1
- Remain calm
- State your name, location, nature of the emergency and stay on the line until directed
- Watch for the arrival of emergency personnel and direct them to the emergency location

Shelter-in-Place

- If inside and in a safe location, stay where you are
- If outdoors, listen and look for directives to proceed to designated buildings
- Locate an interior room to shelter inside.
- Shut windows, vents and exterior doors
- Call University Police and provide location and list of individuals with you



Fires & Evacuations

- Immediately **evacuate** at the sound of the alarm
- If you discover a fire, pull the nearest fire alarm
- Collect immediate belongings and exit by the nearest designated route
- Support those that may need assistance
- Close doors as you leave
- DO NOT USE ELEVATORS
- Proceed to your designated assembly area
- Do not return to the building until directed by University Police

Persons Requiring Assistance

- Assist individuals that may need assistance
- Use a designated buddy system
- Move to the building's nearest Area of Rescue Assistance
- Notify emergency responders of your location via emergency telephone if available

Active Shooter

- **GET OUT:** If possible, exit the building and run
- CALL OUT: After securing yourself, call 911
- **HIDE OUT:** Find a safe place to hide, or Play Dead
- KEEP OUT: Lock and barricade doors, close windows, turn off lights and AV equipment
- REMAIN until directed by University Police
- TAKE OUT: If getting out is not an option, your only chance may be to fight to try to take the shooter out
- Follow all directions given by Law Enforcement officers
