How to Apply for a Parking Permit

1. Access the Parking Portal

- Log into your my.Scranton portal.
- o Click "VIEW ALL CARDS" in upper right corner of homepage.
- o Scroll down to the Parking and Transportation card.
- Select Parking Portal, then click <u>If you are a student, faculty or staff member, please click here.</u> (do not create a new account).
- Click Request new Permit on Permit Icon and follow instructions. Be prepared to provide your vehicle's make, model, color, and license plate number (VIN is not required).

3. Permit Delivery

4. EV Charging Stations

- An EV parking pass is required to use EV charging stations on campus-see campus parking map for locations.
- o EV permits are available for purchase at the Parking Office.
- Both a valid U/S parking permit and an EV permit must be displayed when using the charging stations.

5. Parking Locations

- o Refer to the Campus Parking Map to identify designated lots by permit type.
- Make sure your vehicle is parked in the appropriate lot or space that corresponds to the permit displayed.
