#### **General Notes:**

Act 24 of 2011 removed the requirement for Basic Skills Tests for certification applicants who are already certified or licensed by the state of Pennsylvania. All students who are seeking initial certification must show evidence of passing the Basic Skills test as well as the appropriate Praxis II/PECT tests for their certification area.

Test results must be sent to PDE directly from the test provider. If you test in PA, scores are automatically sent to PDE. If you test outside of PA, you must request that your scores are sent to PDE. Basic Skills tests are valid for life. Content tests are usually valid for ten years.

World language candidates have the option of taking either the Praxis or the ACTFL tests. Latin is only available through Praxis. More information on the ACTFL option may be obtained at <a href="www.actfl.org">www.actfl.org</a>

ETS test codes that begin with "5" or "6" are delivered in computer format; codes that begin with "0" or "1" are delivered on paper. All tests are paper-delivered tests unless otherwise noted.

It is ultimately the candidate's responsibility to register, pay for and take the appropriate tests for a given certification area. #### **PAPA** tests

The qualifying score is **220** for each module (Reading, Writing, and Math).

If candidates fail to score the required 220 on one of the three modules, they have an option to use the Composite Scoring Method to meet the PDE requirements for pre-professional skills assessment.

To use the Composite Scoring Method:

- 1. The sum of the three PAPA modules must total or exceed **686**.
- 2. At least one of the three modules must be at least 220.
- 3. There are also minimum scores when using this method:

a. PAPA Reading
b. PAPA Math
c. PAPA Writing
Minimum = 197
Minimum = 192
