

Keystone Course (HONR 287H) FAQs

What is the Keystone Course?

This is an interdisciplinary course that is team-taught by two faculty members from different departments. A different course is offered each semester.

Does the Keystone Course satisfy any degree requirements?

Yes, this course carries a General Education designation. Some courses may carry 2 GE designations. The GE designations change each semester depending on the topic.

Can a Keystone Course count for more than 1 GE designation?

No, you may only apply 1 designation to your graduation requirements. DegreeWorks will automatically select where it thinks it fits best for you. If you'd prefer it to satisfy a different GE designation, talk to the Registrar's Office to switch it.

How many credits is the Keystone Course?

3 credits

When should I take it?

You can take it anytime during your 5 semesters in the program. Choose the semester that works the best for you and/or the topic that most interests you.

How do I register for the course?

Online when you register for your other classes. Be aware that the number of seats in the course each semester is limited.

Can I take more than one Keystone Course?

Yes.
