The IMA's Award of Excellence is presented to the top student chapters that qualified for Gold Status, and in order to qualify for this achievement, the student chapter had to facilitate/sponsor numerous student events focused on the Certified Management Accountant (CMA) exam, ethics, and other educational opportunities in addition to participating in the IMA's national student case competition, its national student manuscript competition, and the Student Leadership Conference in Charlotte, North Carolina. ## Seven Students Receive CMA Exam Scholarships


