



Federal Direct PLUS Loan for Graduate Students Request Form

This Loan Request is for the Federal Direct PLUS Loan for Graduate students and is a request for the mandatory credit review required for the Direct PLUS Loan for Graduate students. All data must be provided in order for the credit review to be processed.

The Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan is available to credit-worthy Graduate students who have exhausted their Federal Direct Stafford Loan eligibility in an academic year. Graduate students are required to complete a FAFSA and first utilize the Direct Stafford Loan Program prior to borrowing under the Direct PLUS Loan for Graduate Students.

In order to request the Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan, please send an email message from your University of Scranton email account to: finaid@scranton.edu. Include the following information in the request:

1. STUDENT INFORMATION

2. LOAN TERM REQUESTED

Apply for full academic year. Loans will be processed for the entire academic year unless the student is attending only one term or the Financial Aid Office determines the loan must be processed for one term.

3. LOAN AMOUNT REQUESTED

Graduate PLUS Loan Amount Requested

PLEASE NOTE: 4.228% fee is deducted from the loan amount requested. You will need to borrow more than you owe to receive enough funds to pay the bill. Please multiply the amount requested by .95772 and include calculated fee in the Total Loan Amount Requested. For example, the loan amount requested is \$10,000 x .95772, if your approved you will receive \$9,577. The loan amount requested would be \$10,000.

4. E-sign your Direct Graduate PLUS Loan Master Promissory Note if you are a first time borrower or if your Direct Graduate PLUS Loan was approved with a credit-worthy endorser in the prior year. Visit scranton.edu/financialaid, click on Loans & Financing Options, select Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loans, and E-sign Your Direct PLUS Loan Master Promissory Note. Follow the process.
