Yammer is less about day-to-day teamwork and more about information sharing and community building.
	Who	Anyone with a verified email address from University of Scranton can join, participate in and create content or Yammer communities.
	Where	Yammer content can only be created within the Yammer online community.
	When	Often compared to Teams, Yammer is generally used as a gathering place that allows people to join groups that are important or interesting to them.
	Why	Yammer is an excellent tool for enterprise-wide open and transparent communications such as announcements, updates, requests for feedback, etc.
	How	In a web browser, select Yammer from the Microsoft App Launcher or install the Yammer app on your mobile device.
Create	Prior to creating a Yammer community, individuals should consider the following. Can you identify and articulate the purpose of the community? Can you identify a target audience for the community? If the community is central to your work or the work of your department, should the creation of this community be a collaborative endeavor within your department? Have you confirmed a social media page intended to serve the same purpose does not already exist on another social media platform? Have you reviewed the Office of Public Relation's guidance for Social Media Best Practices? Permissions are determined during community creation and should be considered carefully.
