Discovery	What	Microsoft Stream is an Enterprise Video service where people in your organization can upload, view, and share videos securely. You can share recordings of classes, meetings, presentations, training sessions, or other videos that aid your team's collaboration
	Who	Microsoft Stream is the video management and sharing service for employees at all levels across businesses of all sizes who are interested in using videos in the workplace to connect, collaborate, learn and share information.
	Where	Stream can be accessed through the app or through stream.microsoft.com .
	When	You can share recordings of classes, meetings, presentations, training sessions, or other videos that aid your team's collaboration.
	Why	Stream can be used to enhance or aid in collaboration.
	How	In a browser select Stream through the Microsoft app launcher.
Create	Stream is provisioned as part of O365. Users can be invited by coworkers through invitation from the navigation bar. This allows them to view already uploaded videos and share them with you.	
Active	Application	Through the App or from the web at stream.microsoft.com .

Retire	Content is controlled by the user. Users are responsible to review content annually and if it hasn't been viewed recently or is out of date, please retire or update content.	
Dispose / Archive	Each administrative area is responsible to determine the retiring or removing content in stream.
