## Information about Installing the OneDrive client on your Mac computer

The downloadable OneDrive desktop application—also known as the desktop client—gives you access to your OneDrive directly through a folder on your hard drive.

The client runs in the background and automatically keeps your files in sync and backed up online - any time you save a change to a file and are connected to the internet, that change will sync everywhere you have OneDrive installed. This client replaces all preexisting Microsoft clients including the SkyDrive and OneDrive for Business Clients.


## Download the OneDrive client


**Please note:** Please uninstall all previous installations of OneDrive and/or OneDrive for Business sync clients before proceeding.


- 1. Open the App Store
- 2. Search for OneDrive.
- 3. When you have found the app, click GET.
- 4. Click INSTALL APP.
- 5. Sign in with your Apple ID and Password in order to download the app. You may be prompted to enter an ID Verification Code.
- 6. Click Open.



- 7. In the Set up OneDrive window, enter your scranton.edu email.
- 8. Click Sign in.







9. Select Work or school.


10. Enter your my.scranton password when prompted.

11. Click Sign In.

12. Select *Choose OneDrive Folder Location* for easy access to your files.

13. To leave the default location, simply click Choose this location.

14. Click Next.
