Updates

The University's campus remains closed due to the Stay-at-Home order issued by the Governor of Pennsylvania, which remains in effect at least until May 8. Students do not have access to campus buildings at this time, except for limited access for residential students who received permission to remain on campus. Residential students understandably want to know when they can retrieve personal belongings. Robert Davis Jr. Ed.D., Vice President for Student Life, will share specific instructions for all residential students regarding when and how they can return for their personal items as soon as we have a clearer picture of the when the government restrictions will be lifted. - The Athletics Department will offer a **Q & A via Zoom with Bill Wennington**, three-time NBA champion who currently provides color commentary for the Chicago Bulls, on Thursday, April 30, at 7 p.m. Dave Martin, Executive Director of Athletics, will moderate the discussion. - The Division of Information Technology has extended administrative access to remote desktops. The remote desktop environment (available at remote.scranton.edu) provides access to a wide variety of University software from your own device, such as the H:\ and G:\ network drives. Information Technology has been monitoring its usage closely, and have determined that administrative access to this environment can be extended from 8 p.m. to 12 p.m., while still ensuring that students and faculty can continue to use this service.
