Dear Members of the University Community,

This is the final weekly update for the semester regarding Royals Safe Together – A Plan to Reopen Campus.

Communications during the summer months will be sent on an as-needed basis by the Acting President, President and other members of Cabinet or members of the University community. In the meantime, the University continues to follow the health and safety protocols as outlined in the Royals Safe Together Plan, which includes wearing masks while on campus, among other measures.

Report of Active Cases of SARS-CoV-2 on Campus for Spring Semester For the spring semester, the University conducted weekly campus surveillance tests of students and employees for the SARS-CoV-2 virus. The cumulative positivity rate on surveillance testing the spring semester was .64% on 14,325 tests processed.

· In the coming weeks, we will update the University community on any changes to health and safety protocols for the summer, on a return to full staffing of University offices and on detailed plans for the fall semester.

Updates

- Jeffrey P. Gingerich, Ph.D., Acting President, <u>updated the University</u> <u>community</u> regarding vaccine expectations for students for the fall <u>semester</u>.
 - The University will require all students attending in-person classes or accessing campus for other reasons to be fully vaccinated by August 27, 2021.
 - The University will follow its <u>Vaccination Policy</u> for the SARS-CoV-2 vaccine. As with other required vaccinations, students may request a waiver in accordance with Pennsylvania law.

 - Students who have already been vaccinated can upload their vaccine card to their <u>Student Health Portal</u> by following the link and choosing the COVID-19 Vaccine Card option.
 - While the University is not mandating vaccination at this time for employees, we continue to discuss this possibility, and reserve the right to do so in the future.
