Updates

- The University will begin **the gradual reopening of campus on June 22.** Plans developed by University departments will limit the number of staff members returning to campus and will meet or exceed CDC and state health and safety guidelines, which include social distancing and the requirement of wearing a mask on campus.
- Students who have completed their degree requirements and fulfilled all obligations to the University will have their diplomas mailed to their official mailing address today, June 15. When shipped, the USPS tracking number will be emailed to each student's scranton.edu email address. Questions regarding diplomas may be directed to registrar@scranton.edu.
- Printing and Mailing Services will begin summer hours on Monday, June 22. Service will be offered only from the Jefferson Avenue building Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Effective June 22, mail and package delivery will also resume once a day to departments on campus which are open; departments will no longer need to pick up their mail from 315 Jefferson Avenue.
